Records of manure application on land managed by the dairy operator must be kept and maintained for five years. If any applications result in an unauthorized release of manure from solids, slurry or liquid storage or cropland either off-property or to surface water complete a non-compliance event document and follow instructions to notify the Regional Water Quality Control Board.
